

PARENT AND PLAYER AGREEMENT

As a player, I will

- Be ready to learn and work cooperatively each day; listen and follow instructions.
- Show up on time for practices, games, and other events. Be ready to go and properly dressed, which includes hats and all equipment.
- Demonstrate respect for coaches, teammates, opponents, officials, and for the sport itself.
- Put forth my best effort, take responsibility and display a positive attitude in all that I do
- Communicate with my coaches as necessary for me to be responsible and to progress.

As a parent, I will

- Support the program, manager, coaches, and most of all, my child's effort.
- Take the long view of my child's development and not get caught up in the anxieties of the moment.
- Focus on my child's development; not on winning or losing, or on playing time or position.
- Communicate with the coaches as necessary to create a positive learning environment.
- Respect decisions of game officials and, in all ways, model good sportsmanship.
- Go on the field or to the dugout during practices and games ONLY by request of the manager.
- Take any concerns or questions promptly and appropriately to the head coach or manager.
- Help my child practice on his own, be timely and be responsible for his uniform and gear
- Support my child in developing and sticking to long-term goals.
- I agree to sign up for a time/date to work the concession stand. It is expected by the AYL that all players' parents work at least one game day. If you do not sign up, your child will sit the bench until you do so.

Consequences of missed games/practices and poor attitudes

- If your child misses two (2) or more practices, they will set out one entire game. They will be expected to attend and be dressed for that game to support their team.
- Poor attitude and/or sportsmanship will NOT be tolerated in practices or games.
 - o First offense Player will set out the first three (3) innings of next game.
 - Second Offense Player will be benched for one (1) entire game
 - o Third Offense Player will be benched for two (2) entire games
 - o Fourth Offense Player will be terminated for remainder of the season

We have read the agreement and support the partnership between our child, our family, and Adena Youth Baseball. We understand that if we choose not to abide by this agreement, Adena Baseball has the right to not allow our child to participate or continue to participate.
